Sample Church Talking Points

The Problem:

- State: 78,000 abortions in New York
 - o NY is the abortion capital of the nation with the most abortions per capita
 - o NY was the first state to legalize abortion (July 1, 1970) and has some of the most permissive abortion laws in the world
 - Abortion was deemed a "fundamental human right" in 2019 with the passage of the Reproductive Health Act
- County (Erie and Monroe are the sites of CompassCare's two offices)
 - o Erie County: 3,200 abortions annually (24% of all pregnancies end in abortion)
 - o Monroe County: 1,800 abortions annually (19% of all pregnancies end in abortion)
- Women:
 - o Primarily get abortions because they feel alone and unsupported
 - o Abortion represents the abandonment of women in need
- Preborn: denial of their personhood, death for boys and girls in the womb

"The abortion problem is a symptom of a deep cultural disease that springs from a fundamental misunderstanding of what it means to be human under God. Only the Church can deal with the root and fruit of this cultural malaise."

Solution:

- "Erase the need for abortion by transforming a woman's fear into confidence"
- To serve women seriously considering abortion in our communities with compassionate, nonjudgmental, and ethical medical care, providing comprehensive support and an opportunity to hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ
- The Church through CompassCare can erase abortion from our community by serving one woman, and saving one baby at a time

<u>Results</u>:

- 2020 was a record-setting, life-saving year with 390 babies saved from abortion (a 15% increase) and 191 women surrendered their lives to Christ (a 35% increase)
- 2021: 80 preborn lives saved and 51 salvations as of 3/15/20
